Classes

Young, 16 months plus, non-competing dogs may enter graded classes if they can attempt all the equipment in a course environment. All agility courses will include full height, aframe, seasaw, dog walk and weave, all jumping courses will include a weave.

Grade 1-4 speedstakes will be a flowing course of jumps and tunnels.

Training within the ring is allowed and will be timed to the course time. A toy in the ring is allowed, as is a treat ball. No crumbly treats anywhere in the venue please for the sake of all dogs.

You are welcome to attempt the course or simply take your course time and train.

Class 1 and 2, class 3 and 4, class 5 and 6 etc. will be the same for all heights and will be walked together. For example, grade 1-4 speedstakes will be walked by everyone at 8.30am and will then run in the following height order micro, small, medium, 550 and large. There will not be a break between medium and 550 for further course walking.

You may run your dog at any height and you may run in whichever graded class you prefer, however grade 7 large dogs choosing to run a grade 4 class at medium height for confidence will not be eligible for competition.

All the grade 1-4 classes will be run in the morning.

Equipment

Jaycee Jumps equipment, including rubber contacts, tunnels and indoor weave

Flooring is sand. Timing, electronic and/or manual.

Venue

Coxhill Equestrian Centre, Candie, Falkirk, FK2 0BU. Just off the A801 between the M8 and M9.

Facilities

Toilet on site, please note that a separate exercise area will not be available. However, there are lots of good dog walking spots locally, along the canal, at Muiravonside Country Park etc..

Tea/coffee snacks available.

2) Paper entry forms complete with a cheque made payable to Stirling Dog Agility, with cash or with bacs payment. Bacs payment must be made at the time of submission, for the entry to be accepted.
